Requirements for Dual Citizenship

Republic Act No. 9225 allows former natural born Filipinos to reacquire their Philippine citizenship. **Your application shall not be processed in case of error or omission. Applicants should appear at the Embassy in person.**

Following are the requirements for application:

- Duly accomplished application form (2 copies)
- Three (3) recently taken 2x2 photos (colored, royal blue background, and with collar)
- Certificate of Naturalization (original and 2 copies)
- Irish Passport (original and 2 copies of the data [Photo] page)

Any of the following documents:

- Old Philippine Passport or Birth Certificate printed on NSO Security Paper
- Old Philippine Passport or Birth Certificate printed on NSO Security Paper (original and 2 copies)
- Notarized Affidavit of Change of Name (if name is different from the birth certificate) (original and 2 copies)
- Report of Marriage (if applicant's marriage was celebrated outside the Philippines). (original and 2 copies)
- Marriage contract printed on NSO Security Paper (if marriage was celebrated in the Philippines). (original and 2 copies)

PAYMENT OF VISA FEES: Personal cheques/credit cards/laser cards are not accepted. Please make your payments in CASH or IRISH POSTAL ORDER payable to the Philippine Embassy.

SCHEDULE OF FEES: Application fee of €50

PROCESSING TIME:

On the day of application an appointment will be made for the applicant to have their Oath taking. Appointments for Oath taking are given based on the availability of both the Consul General and the applicant.
