

Personal appearance for all passport applicants is required. Each application must be submitted with the following:

1. A duly accomplished passport application form ([click here](#)).
2. Latest passport.
3. One (1) photocopy each of the passport's data page(s), last page and latest visa page. For brown passports, submit a copy of the pages which show the data and picture of the applicant (pages 1-3).
4. If applicant's last passport is the brown one, which only shows the applicant's middle initial, a copy of any VALID IDENTIFICATION CARD which shows their WHOLE MIDDLE NAME must also be provided.
Acceptable forms of Identification are:
 - Driver's License
 - Certified Copy of Birth Certificate or Marriage Certificate
 - Baptismal Certificate
5. Passport fee is €60.00. Accepted forms of payment are cash, postal money order, payable to the Philippine Embassy in Dublin. Personal checks, credit or debit cards are not accepted.
6. Applicants are no longer required to submit photos. Since photo-taking is embedded in the new system, photos will be taken at the Embassy at no charge.
7. For those who have re-acquired Philippine citizenship under RA 9225:
 - a. Old Philippine Passport;
 - b. Original and photocopy of Oath of Allegiance;
 - c. Original and photocopy of Order of Approval;
 - d. Original and photocopy of Identification Certificate.

B. Replacement of Lost Passport

The following are the requirements for applications for the replacement of Lost Passports:

1. Notarized Affidavit of Loss, which should include the following information: Details of Lost Passport (e.g. date and place where it was issued and passport number), narration of the circumstances on how the passport got lost.
2. Copies of state ID or driver's license, GNIB card, or any other valid photo identification.
3. NSO- certified Birth Certificate.
4. Police/Garda Report.
5. Fee: € 150.00.

A 15-day waiting period, on top of the 3-5 week processing period, will be imposed if the lost passport is still valid (unexpired).
